Should I have a PSA test?

Prostate cancer is the most common cancer in Australian men. Each year, over 25,000 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer and around 3,700 will die from it. The recommendations are that men over age 50, or over the age of 40 with a family history of prostate cancer, should talk to their doctor about testing for prostate cancer as part of their regular health check-ups. It is important that you make an informed decision about testing based on the latest available evidence on the benefits and potential harms of testing and subsequent treatment for prostate cancer.

What are the potential benefits of PSA testing?

- PSA testing can reduce a man's risk of dying from prostate cancer.
- In a man with no symptoms, PSA testing can detect a potentially harmful cancer before it spreads.
- Early detection and treatment of a harmful cancer increases the chance it can be cured.
- If you are concerned about prostate cancer, regular PSA testing can put your mind at rest.

New Early Drop Delivery Surcharge

Our freight costs have increased significantly over the past six months due to a variety of factors. Rather than imposing a blanket increase of our delivery charges, we have identified a number of areas where some process changes can be made to improve efficiencies. One of these changes does involve a delivery surcharge, which will only apply to deliveries which require a set time delivery before 9am. There will be \$15 surcharge if a first drop delivery is required and a \$10 surcharge if a delivery is required before 9am. This surcharge won't apply if we don't have a set time before 9am restriction requirement.

These surcharges will begin in October 2024.

Price Increases

Due to the recent increase in global shipping costs and local inflationary pressures our Engineered Wood Products will be increasing from 1st November 2024. This will apply to all deliveries of Engineered Wood Products and related items from that date forward. If you have any projects using Engineered Wood Products that will begin after this date, please give your Sales Rep a call to have you quotes updated in line with these changes.

All LVLs - increase approx. 7%
I-Joist - increase between 4% & 7%

Rim board, Web stiffeners, Hardware and other related products - increase between 5% & 10%

If you are experiencing cash flow difficulties, we ask that you communicate this with us as soon as possible. We are aware there are still delays with some trades, it is a challenging labour market, which then makes it hard to get stage payments, but if we can't get in contact with you, we will have no choice but to place your account on stop credit and / or begin alternative debt collection action if payment terms are breached. If we are aware of your situation, we may be able to assist, but avoiding our calls is not ideal, particularly as we are required to report our customers to a number of authorities once an account is 90 days overdue.

We are seeing improvements in quote request lead times at our Truss and Frame plant.

The approximate lead time for quotes are as follows:

Quotes - Frames & Trusses - approx. 5-7 Working days (standard residential quotes)

Quotes - Frames & Trusses - approx. 2-3 Working days (carport quotes)

Quotes - Frames & Trusses - approx. 16 Working days (multi-residential & commercial quotes)

We have received a rush of orders throughout August which now sees us fully booked for frames, trusses and posijoists for the 2024 year. As we have found over the last few years, things do change for a variety of reasons, particularly with the weather, so we will keep you informed should any openings emerge.

Any new orders will need to be placed from January 2025 onwards.


